## 2023 Budget Notes:

The overall property assessment in Poplar Bay increase by 3.2% in 2023 compared to 2022.

The 2023 Municipal Property Taxes increased by 2% (\$5,912) to \$301,418 compared to \$295,506 in 2022.

The 2022 Provincial Requisitions increased by 6.6% (\$15,379) to \$248,307 compared to \$232,928 in 2022.

The Municipal minimum Property Tax remained at \$600 for 2022.

The Annual Wastewater Utility fee for 2023 remained at \$240 for all properties.

The Annual Wastewater fees are used to fund the regional wastewater expenses, local wastewater expense and build reserves used to help fund future Capital Projects.
